I learned that yesterday was World Gratitude Day (don't worry, I forgot to get you a card, too!).

I found a quote by theologian and author, Dianna Butler Bass (we used her book, *Freeing Jesus: Rediscovering Jesus as Friend, Teacher, Savior, Lord, Way and Presence* as the basis for our summer sermon series) that speaks to the power of gratitude:

"Gratitude is resilience of sorts, the defiance of kindness in the face of anger, of connection in the face of division, and of hope in the face of fear. . . Gratitude empowers us. It makes joy and love possible. It rearranges the way we see and experience what is all around us. Gratitude makes all things new. It transforms how we understand what is broken and gives us the ability to act more joyfully and with hope. That is why gratitude is central to all the world's religions. As a practice, it embodies the wisdom of humanity's greatest spiritual teachers: the love of neighbor. Gratitude takes us from abstract belief to living compassion in the world."

It seems to me that gratitude isn't always easy because life isn't always rainbows and unicorns; it can be difficult to find gratitude in difficult times. But, as Butler Bass reminds us, choosing to be grateful can change the

way we see the world around us. The more we can practice noticing the gifts of life all around us, the more we are able to find the strength to overcome the anxiety and fear and suspicion that not only lurk in the corners of our hearts, but are so prevalent in the world today.

So don't worry that, like me, you missed out on World Gratitude Day; it's never too late to be grateful. Look around you and count your blessings, and find things for which you are grateful. Even more, find someone who might benefit from a kind word or deed and pay your gratitude forward.

For gratitude is not a once-a-year celebration but a way of life.


Several WIPC folks, including Pastor Andy, participated in the District I Pilgrimage Day Trip in Savannah last Saturday.


• **December 9**th, **Deacons' Winter Festival:** our annual event for the children of our church and community, 11:00 - 2:00.


