

This Sunday, we begin our season of Advent, a time to prepare not our homes for the coming of the Christ Child, but our hearts. At the very first Christmas, Luke tells us that soon after Mary had given birth to her son, Jesus, a group of shepherds showed up telling them about a heavenly host that had announced to them the birth of the Messiah. Mary wasn't sure what to make of all that they were saying and doing, but Luke tells us Mary "treasured all these words and *pondered* them in her heart." (Luke 2:19).

I have always liked the word "ponder," and my prayer is that in the coming weeks as we prepare for the coming anew of Christ, we, like Mary, will ponder all the events surrounding that very first Christmas. May we ponder what it means that God would choose to come to us, would choose to be born as one of us; may we ponder how this little baby would grow to be the man who shows us the fullness of God's love; may we ponder how Christ is still at work in our world and in our lives today.

And may all our pondering lead us to a deeper, richer faith in God, and a deeper, richer appreciation of the love and hope and peace of this season.


Be a Santa's Elf




