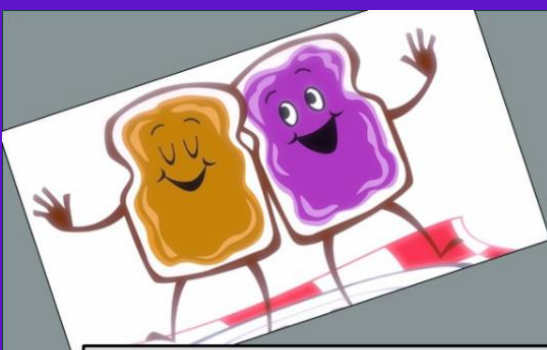

OLD TESTAMENT SURVEY

This course explores Old Testament literature in its historical, cultural, and theological contexts.
